

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

UNIVERSITY OF BRIDGEPORT

AND

Tulsiramji Gaikwad-Patil College of Engineering and Technology

- Tulsiramji Gaikwad-Patil College of Engineering and Technology and the University of Bridgeport (UB) established this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to foster international cooperation in education, research, and academic exchange. Both institutions seek to develop mutually beneficial programs for their students, faculty, departments, and research institutes within the provisions of this MOU.
- This MOU represents a commitment by both institutions to enter into discussion and negotiation concerning the activities listed below. The two institutions affirm that these discussions would conclude in various agreements and implementations that are mutually beneficial.

Potential programs and activities between the two institutions may include, but are not limited to the following:

- a. Acceptance of qualified graduates from the undergraduate programs in Tulsiramji Gaikwad-Patil College of Engineering and Technology to the University of Bridgeport graduate programs, as per UB's licensure and accreditation requirements; and regular admission requirements.
 - b. Exchange of faculty for instruction, research and lectures.
 - c. joint conferences, seminars, and workshops.
- Proposal's, including suggestions not reflected in this MOU, may be discussed and implemented on the basis of the specific agreements to be signed by both institutions.

This Agreement will be effective from the date of signature and shall remain in effect for three years and, thereafter, it shall automatically renew for successive one-year renewal periods. This MOU may be amended by the written consent of both the parties.




